confirms the right to use the waters of WELL #42 AND WELL #53, in the NORTH INLET BASIN, for MAINTAINING HORSFALL LAKE WATER LEVEL FOR RECREATION.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10839. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 27, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 74.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The right shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
