CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT AND PHYLLIS PRICHARD
19376 N SANTIAM HWY
STAYTON OR 97383

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, tributary to SANTIAM RIVER for IRRIGATION of 15.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-33254. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 7, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

9 S	1 E	WM	22	NW NE	7	1420 FEET NORTH AND 2050 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 22

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

9 S	1 E	WM	22	SE NW	6	1230 FEET NORTH AND 2820 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 22

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at each point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 10, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 912, approving Transfer Application 10743, and together with Certificate 86240, supercedes Certificate 42099, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
