CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LAWRENCE AND NETTIE DOWNING 5200 NE MILL CREEK RD PRINEVILLE OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, tributary to CROOKED RIVER for IRRIGATION of 37.5 ACRES AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1870.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.47 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

A. The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order at the new point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 22, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 108, approving Transfer Application 10921, and together with Certificate 86036, supercedes Certificate 80751, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
