CONFEDERATED TRIBES OF THE UMATILLA INDIAN RESERVATION

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK WALLA WALLA RIVER, tributary to WALLA WALLA RIVER for FISH CULTURE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, at Page 9.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.61 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), WITH AN ANNUAL DUTY OF 97.0 ACRE FEET (AF), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, AND IS DELINEATED BY PRIORITY DATE AS FOLLOWS:

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

When using water under this right, the water user shall record the amounts used under this right daily and will make the record available to the Watermaster upon request.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 28, 2007, at Special Order Volume 73, Page 140, approving Transfer Application 10019, and supercedes Certificate 81151, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
