CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DENNIS AND JACQUELINE JACOBS
2269 FROZEN CREEK RD
MYRTLE CREEK OR 97457

confirms the right to use the waters of FROZEN CREEK, tributary to SOUTH FORK UMPQUA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 2.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 3616. The date of priority is DECEMBER 3, 1917. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.026 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
28 S	4 W	WM	29	SW NE	443 FEET NORTH & 87 FEET EAST FROM C1/4 CORNER, SECTION 29

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Acres
28 S	4 W	WM	29	SW NE	2.1

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
28 S	4 W	WM	20	SW SE	40 RODS NORTH & 100 RODS WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 20

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 11, 1997, Special Order Volume 51, Page 282, approving Transfer Application 6724, and supercedes Certificate 3236, State record of Water Right Certificates.
