CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SAM AND CONNIE START 1100 N FOURTH LAKEVIEW OR 97630

confirms the right to use the waters of A SUMP in GOOSE LAKE BASIN for IRRIGATION of 30.71 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8708. The date of priority is JUNE 18, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.38 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 25, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 1014, approving Transfer Application 8539, and supercedes Certificate 58076, State record of Water Right Certificates.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
