CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MINNIE E. WILSON-HERPICH
MILTON-FREEWATER, OREGON 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 0.84 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, at Page 9. The date of priority is 1873. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE AND ONE-HALF MINER'S INCHES (0.0375 cubic foot per second) PER ACRE, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

being within the following described tract: Beginning at the northwest corner of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 18, T. 5 N., R. 36 E., W. M., running thence East 38 rods; thence southeasterly 21 rods; thence west 45 rods and 12 feet to the west line of Sec. 18; thence north 19 rods to the place of beginning, containing 5 acres, more or less.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 12769, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 16 2013, approving Notice T-11611.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
