confirms the right to use the waters of WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 9.7 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, at Page 9. The date of priority is 1877. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE AND ONE-HALF MINER'S INCHES (0.0375 cubic foot per second) PER ACRE, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 59 rods west of the center of Sec. 18, T. 5 N., R. 36 E., W. M., on the east and west center line of said Sec. 18; running thence South 20 Degrees 45 Minutes East 12 rods; thence South 51 Degrees 37 Minutes West 32 rods to the east bank of the Walla Walla River; thence northwesterly along said east bank of the Walla River, to said east and west center line; thence east 74 rods to the point of beginning, containing 10.0 acres, more or less, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION due to Government Action (ORS 540.510(6)), approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 16 2013, regarding Notice T-11611, and supersedes Certificate 13157, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place or use herein described.
