CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TED DOLE 262 OBENCHAIN RD EAGLE POINT OR 97524

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, tributary to ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 20.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 14, at Page 498. The date of priority is 1874.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.28 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; Measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department. The water user shall maintain the headgate as required by the Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 30, 2009, at Special Order Volume 79, Page 146, approving Transfer Application 10792, and supercedes Certificate 50149, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
