CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of BRIDGE CREEK, tributary to JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION of 24.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wheeler County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, at Page 388. The date of priority is 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre land irrigated before June 15, and ONE-EIGHTEITH of one cubic foot per second per acres after June 15, during the irrigation season from March 1 to October 1 of each year (0.59 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or by-pass device, in accordance with the provisions of ORS 540.525.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 21, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 816, approving Transfer Application 7962, and together with Certificate 75800, supercedes Certificate 13556, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
