CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of MIDDLE BRANCH OF MUD CREEK, tributary to EAST BRANCH OF MUD CREEK for IRRIGATION OF 20.8 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 322. The date of priority is 1893 for 2.3 acres and 1896 for 18.5 acres.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.257 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.


When required by the Department the water user shall install, maintain and operate an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 21, 2008, at Special Order Volume 75, Page 402, approving Transfer Application 10509, and together with Certificate 84205, supercedes Certificate 1736, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
