 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARVIN L AND MARTHA J GINSBURG  
 13757 UPPER COW CR RD  
 AZALEA OR 97410

confirms the right to use the waters of SNOW CREEK, tributary to COW CREEK for IRRIGATION of 33.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-25833. The date of priority is OCTOBER 10, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.47 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

32 S	3 W	WM	6	NW NE	210 FEET SOUTH AND 2530 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 6

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of water in Cow Creek is 11.0 cubic feet per second or more at its mouth.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point(s) of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

32 S	3 W	WM	6	SW SE	4580 FEET SOUTH AND 2430 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 6

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 6, 2000, at Special Order Volume 54, Page 879, approving Transfer Application 8306, and together with Certificate 76635, supercedes Certificate 37097, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
