CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RIVERSIDE FAMILY FARM PO BOX 10008 EUGENE OR 97440

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, tributary to ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 16.7 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is MAY, 1887.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year (0.332 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSOIN AND PARTIAL CANCELLATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 3, 2007, at Special Order Volume 72, Page 554, approving Transfer Application 9532, and together with Certificate 83415, supercedes Certificate 80885, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
