 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DANA AND MARALEE WESTBROOK
 149 ROLLING RIDGE RD

confirms the right to use the waters of CALAPOOYA CREEK, tributary to UMPQUA RIVER for POND MAINTENANCE OF A RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-5772.

This right was perfected under Permit S-30304. The date of priority is MARCH 18, 1965. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

At no time shall the water user divert more than 0.01 cubic foot per second (960 gallons per day).

The point of diversion is located as follows:

25 S	6 W	WM	12	SW SW	49	2090 FEET SOUTH AND 860 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 12

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall keep and maintain a record of the monthly quantity of water diverted from the authorized point of diversion.

The water user shall report to the Watermaster monthly the quantity of water diverted.

Notwithstanding that Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife has made a determination that a fish screen and/or by-pass device are not necessary at this time, the water user may be required in the future to install, maintain, and operate fish screening and/or by-pass devices to prevent fish from entering the diversion, and to provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 26, 2007, at Special Order Volume 73, Page 837, approving Transfer Application 10085, and supersedes Certificate 40762, State record of Water Right Certificates.
