CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LA GRANDE COUNTRY CLUB  
10605 S MCALISTER RD  
ISLAND CITY OR 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the GRANDE RONDE RIVER BASIN, for PRIMARY COMMERCIAL USE INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF A GOLF COURSE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2969. The date of priority is JULY 2, 1965.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.81 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, FURTHER LIMITED TO 194.1 ACRE-FEET DURING MARCH 1 TO OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

3 S	38 E	WM	3	SW NE	2020 FEET SOUTH AND 560 FEET EAST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 3

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 13, 2006, at Special Order Volume 70, Page 333, approving Transfer Application 10046, and supercedes Certificate 34395, State record of Water Right Certificates.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
