CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JIM CHAISSON SR
 2200 PINE GATE WAY
 WHITE CITY OR 97503

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the a PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION of 26.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 9600. The date of priority is MARCH 29, 1930. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.33 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	GLot	Measured Distances
35 S	1 W	WM	29	NE SW	6	35 FEET SOUTH & 1800 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 29

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSOIN approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 9, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 953, approving Transfer Application 7646, and together with Certificate 75604, supercedes Certificate 17249, State record of Water Right Certificates.
