CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EUGENE UNDERHILL  
82541 DUFUR VALLEY RD  
DUFUR OR 97021

confirms the right to use the waters of FIFTEENMILE CREEK, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 22.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 7, at Page 406. The date of priority is MARCH 4, 1861.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3.0 ACRE-FEET PER ACRE IN THE IRRIGATION SEASON, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

1 S	13 E	WM	32	SW SW	NONE GIVEN

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 9, 2004, at Special Order Volume 61, Page 48, approving Transfer Application 9565, and supercedes Certificate 39608, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
