CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of MCKAY CREEK (A SHALLOW WELL), tributary to UMATILLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 2.42 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-652. The date of priority is MAY 3, 1911. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.033 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (well), together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 26, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 1305, approving Transfer Application 7106, and together with Certificate 75823 supercedes Certificate 68339, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
