CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

NORTH UNIT IRRIGATION DISTRICT 2024 NW BEECH STREET MADRAS, OR 97741

confirms the right to use the waters of the waters of CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 92.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-33954. The date of priority is September 18, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.31 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is further limited to the combined total amount of water for all other rights perfected under Permit S-33954 which shall not exceed 130.39 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND. The amount of water will be measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right, existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is further subject to the terms and conditions of: 1) a stipulation between the North Unit Irrigation District and the Oregon State Game Commission, recorded in Miscellaneous Records of the Water Resources Department at Volume 4, Page 2028; 2) the Interoffice Memo regarding North Unit Irrigation District Water Accounting dated July 12, 1996, recorded in Miscellaneous Records of the Water Resources Department at Volume 9, Pages 225-226, as modified by the Crooked River Minimum Flow Agreement; and 3) the agreement between North Unit Irrigation District and the Deschutes River Conservancy referred to as the Crooked River Minimum Flow Agreement, recorded in the Miscellaneous Records of the Water Resources Department at Volume 9, Pages 218-224.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
