CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RALPH JACKSON
SPRAY, OR 97874

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 0.5 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-38112. The date of priority is OCTOBER 15, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

8 S	24 E	WM	36	SE SW	1550 FEET SOUTH AND 60 FEET WEST FROM THE E1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in number of acreage described on Certificate 73398. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 73398, and describes the portion of water right Certificate 47668, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 6, 1996, and recorded at Volume 50, Page 790, approving Transfer Application T-6988.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
