CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TUMALO IRRIGATION DISTRICT  
64697 COOK AVE  
BEND, OR 97701

confirms the right to use the waters of UPPER TUMALO RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-2743, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, to SUPPLEMENT ALL USES AND LANDS SERVED BY TUMALO IRRIGATION DISTRICT, including but not limited to Irrigation, Pond Use, Industrial Use, Domestic Use, Stock Use, Supplemental Irrigation, Pond Maintenance, and Storage.

This right was perfected under Permit S-27840. The date of priority is DECEMBER 8, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1,100 ACRE-FEET, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The season of use under this right is April 15 to October 15.

The amount of water used under this right to supplement irrigation or supplemental irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH (1/70) of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Place of Use: All lands served by Tumalo Irrigation District.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 76106, State Record of Water Right Certificates, diminished and modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 18, 2005, approving Allocation of Conserved Water CW-9. This Certificate together with Certificate 81332 supersedes Certificate 76106.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
