## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

### RANDY AND LINDA JOSEPH 37123 HANSEN LANE BAKER CITY OR 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of SUTTON CREEK, tributary to POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 21.8 ACRES.

This right was under permit S-22191. The date of priority is MARCH 13, 1953. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.55 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

### NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Once installed, the water user shall maintain the headgate, in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable measuring device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening or fish by-pass device as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 26, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 878, approving Transfer Application 8726, and together with Certificate 88898, supersedes Certificate 28529, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
