CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the WHYCHUS CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 23.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7092. The date of priority is DECEMBER 26, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.29 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well. The rates are further specified as: 0.15 CFS for lands owned by Apregan and 0.14 CFS for the lands owned by Mansker.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows (Note: The Owner Name information is supplemental information and is not part of the right of record.):

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation, namely the volcanic aquifer, NOT the shallow alluvium aquifer.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 85968, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN. 27 2014, approving Transfer Application T-11603.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
