 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES LOWRY
 MT VERNON, OR 97865

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 29.2 ACRES from TRACT 2.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1885.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and $\frac{3}{4}$ acre foot per acre thereafter; total 5.0 acre feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 39355, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered Oct. 28 2013, approving Transfer Application T-11035.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
