## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVE RUSSEL 1800 DEL RIO RD ROSEBURG OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributary to UMPQUA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.33 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-28837. The date of priority is MAY 13, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The water user will limit water use to an average of one-inch-per-week during the irrigation season of each year, adjusted using the Eugene Water and Electric Board's (or other appropriate entity's) evapo-transpiration information.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the North Umpqua River is more than 525 cfs at its mouth.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Native riparian habitat must be maintained and enhanced along the property boundary with the North Umpqua River.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
