CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOE L AND SALLY MOYA
88041 BILLS CREEK LANE
BANDON OR 97411

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED STREAM, tributary to COQUILLE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-18645. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 28, 1949. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
28 S	14 W	WM	32	SW NW	20 FEET NORTH AND 620 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 32

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year for any crop except cranberries, and 0.1 cubic foot per second or its equivalent for reach acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre-foot for each acre irrigated in any 30-day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6.0 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year for cranberries..

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 24, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 598, approving Transfer Application 7801, and together with Certificate 75719, supersedes Certificate 21685, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
