CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, tributary to SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 9.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1870.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
2 S	38 E	WM	31	SW SW	1858 FEET SOUTH AND 81 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Acres
2 S	38 E	WM	33	NE NW	9.3

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as NESSLEY DITCH.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.


This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 5, 2003, at Special Order Volume 58, Page 119, approving Transfer Application 8356, and together with Certificate 80432, supercedes Certificate 11449, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
