CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, tributary to BALDWIN CREEK (EAST FORK HOOD RIVER) for DOMESTIC USE INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN.

This right was perfected under Permit S-7068. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 30, 1925. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
1 N	10 E	WM	34	NW SW	44 FEET SOUTH AND 1142 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 34

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 12, 2004, at Special Order Volume 59, Page 14, approving Transfer Application 9449, and together with Certificate 80553, supercedes Certificate 8499, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
