confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 32.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1889. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.82 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

12 S	26 E	WM	27	SW SE	1210 FEET NORTH AND 2740 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 27

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; total of five acre feet per acre per season, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion (Murray Ditch) under the subject right.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 83001 and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 30, 2012, at Special Order Volume 87, Page 636, approving Transfer Application T-11350, and together with Certificate 87597, supersedes Certificate 83001, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
