 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JACOB D. WOOD
 11161 TABLE ROCK RD
 CENTRAL POINT OR 97502

confirms the right to use the waters of ANNA CREEK, tributary to WOOD RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 126.5 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 2, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1892.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.59 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS) from APRIL 1st to JULY 20th of each year and 0.80 CFS thereafter until the close of the irrigation season, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source; the quantity delivered not to exceed three acre-feet for each acre irrigated.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to use water for domestic and stock purposes shall continue throughout the year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion (Stormer Ditch).

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 4, 1994, at Special Order Volume 48, Page 108, approving Transfer Application 6138, and together with Certificate 68357, supercedes Certificate 1093, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
