 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROGUE RIVIERA ESTATES HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 1.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-8572. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1928. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.014 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

34 S	1 W	WM	21	SE NE	2	1350 FEET SOUTH AND 1320 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 21

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 21, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 481, approving Transfer Application 8127, and together with Certificate 76921, supersedes Certificate 74671, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
