CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DREWSEY RECLAMATION COMPANY  
DREWSEY, OR 97904

confirms the right to use the waters of the MIDDLE FORK MALHEUR RIVER, tributary of MALHEUR RIVER for IRRIGATION of 586.78 ACRES AND DOMESTIC.

This right was perfected under Permit E-144. The date of priority is JUNE 17, 1912. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 7.33 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

Note: Pursuant to provisions of the order dated June 16, 1948, and recorded at Page 42, Volume 6, Special Order Record, approving transfer Application W-39, the lands identified in the place of use table below by an "\*" before the acreage listing have an alternate point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.



The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
