CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BENJAMIN H SYNON AND SHIRLEY MAE SYNON LIVING TRUSTS
 5020 MILL CREEK RD W
 THE DALLES OR 97058

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for PRIMARY IRRIGATION ON 6.19 ACRES, PRIMARY IRRIGATION TO MAKE UP A DEFICIENCY IN RATE ON 1.5 ACRES EQUIVALENT ON A 17.1 ACRE AREA IN THE NW¼ OF SECTION 18 PERFECTED UNDER PERMIT S-28315, EVIDENCED BY CERTIFICATE 31822, AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION ON 7.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-16727. The date of priority is DECEMBER 20, 1945.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.245 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.103 CFS FOR PRIMARY IRRIGATION ON 6.19 ACRES, 0.025 CFS FOR PRIMARY IRRIGATION TO MAKE UP A DEFICIENCY IN RATE ON 17.1 ACRES, AND 0.117 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION ON 7.0 ACRES, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from APRIL 1 to OCTOBER 1 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The primary irrigation to make up a deficiency in rate on 17.1 acres is combined with the portion of the water right perfected under Permit S-28315, evidenced by Certificate 31822, appurtenant to the same lands. This portion of these water rights shall not be separated in the future.

The total quantity of water diverted under this right and the portion of the right perfected under Permit S-28315, evidence by Certificate 31822, appurtenant to these lands shall be limited to the amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.273 cubic foot per second (CFS), being 0.133 CFS with priority December 20, 1945, and 0.144 CFS with priority August 21, 1962, and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 24.0 acre feet with priority December 20, 1945, and 51.3 acre feet with priority August 21, 1962, provided the total quantity diverted under both rights shall not exceed 70.8 acre feet during the irrigation season, April 1 to October 1, of each year.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgates and measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, COMBINING WATER RIGHTS (MAKE UP A DEFICIENCY IN RATE) AND DIMINISHING A WATER RIGHT approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 4, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 311, approving Transfer Application 6677, and supercedes Certificate 19586, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
