CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, within the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN for INDUSTRIAL USES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1481. The date of priority is OCTOBER 30, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.54 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, FURTHER LIMITED TO 108.5 ACRE FEET DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON MARCH 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

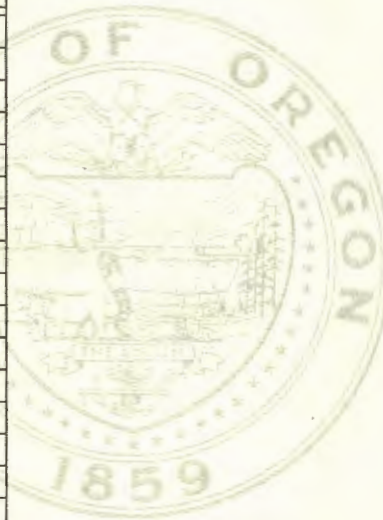

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION, PLACE OF USE, CHARACTER OF USE, AND PARTIAL CANCELLATION OF A WATER RIGHT approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 21, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 302, approving Transfer Application 8111, and supercedes Certificate 31024, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
