

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

confirms the right to use the waters of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 265.6 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 19.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 44954. The dates of priority are FEBRUARY 19, 1980 FOR IRRIGATION OF 237.1 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES, APRIL 17, 1980 FOR IRRIGATION OF 1.5 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 17.8 ACRES, AND JUNE 19, 1980 FOR IRRIGATION OF 27.0 ACRES. The use is limited to not more than 3.57 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 2.99 CFS WITH A PRIORITY DATE OF FEBRUARY 19, 1980, 0.24 CFS WITH A PRIORITY DATE OF APRIL 17, 1980, AND 0.34 CFS WITH A PRIORITY DATE OF JUNE 19, 1980, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.


