

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

confirms the right to use the waters of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 126.1 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL SUPPLY NURSERY OPERATIONS WHICH INCLUDE USE FOR CONTAINERIZED NURSERY STOCK AND IN GREENHOUSES.

This right was perfected under Permit 47405. The date of priority is DECEMBER 7, 1981. The use is limited to not more than 16.08 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 1.58 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 7.0 CFS FOR CONTAINERIZED NURSERY STOCK AND 7.5 CFS FOR USE IN GREENHOUSES, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:


The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
