CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK CROOKED RIVER, a tributary to CROOKED RIVER for IRRIGATION of 119.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1885. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.49 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre for each acre irrigated from February 1st to December 1st of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion (i.e. White Sulfur Ditch at T18SR23E07, 900' N & 600' W from S 1/4 corner, section 7), shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

The water user shall maintain the in line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 23, 1981, at Special Order Volume 35, Page 374, approving Transfer Application 4738, and together with Certificates 87644, supersedes Certificate 587, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
