CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROSEBURG FOREST PRODUCTS
 PO BOX 1088
 ROSEBURG OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributary to UMPQUA RIVER for WOOD PRODUCTS MANUFACTURING INCLUDING LOG STORAGE USE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-26640. The date of priority is MARCH 9, 1960. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.


The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 15, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 1240, approving Transfer Application 6709, and supercedes Certificate 52770, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
