CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 8.4 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1896.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated FROM APRIL 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30, FURTHER LIMITED TO 1.0 ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE PER CALENDAR MONTH TO JULY 1 AND 0.75 ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE THEREAFTER; TOTAL 5.0 ACRE-FEET PER ACRE FOR SEASON, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.



This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 18, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 118, approving Transfer Application 8603, and together with Certificate 79900, supercedes Certificate 25540, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
