CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROCK CREEK DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT COMPANY
 PO BOX 28
 WAMIC OR 97063

confirms the right to use the waters of GATE CREEK AND ROCK CREEK, tributaries of WHITE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 4.0 ACRES and 3.0 ACRES-EQUIVALENT FOR POND MAINTENANCE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-6807. The date of priority is MAY 23, 1925. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.087 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.05 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF 4.0 ACRES AND 0.037 CFS FOR POND MAINTENANCE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain, and operate an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 6, 2008, at Special Order Volume 76, Page 688, approving Transfer Application 10014, together with Certificate 84759, supercedes Certificate 74028, State record of Water Right Certificates.
