## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Jerry Victor Lehman; Cynthia A. Parks; Seth R. Barnard and Candice L. Barnard Revocable Living Trust dated September 8, 2006; Ned Schaaf and Stella Schaaf, Trustees of the Twin Oaks Trust u.a.d. dated February 2, 1990; and Robert M. Miller and Denise W. Miller, Trustees of the Robert and Denise Miller Trust

confirms the right to use the waters of the NEIL CREEK, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 17.0 ACRES and DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1861.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which this right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the water right as ordered by the Motion for Relief From Judgment or Order (Case No. 1203E) signed October 4, 2012, by Judge G Philip Arnold of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The Order recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 19, at Page 317, and corrects the Decree to identify the location of the place of use of a water right in the name of Jackson Gyger and supersedes Certificate 15969.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This right is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
