CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

CORRY WRIGHT 250 S 3600 E HEBER CITY UT 84032

confirms the right to use the waters of TROUT CREEK, tributary to DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION of 10.4 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jefferson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Page 57. The date of priority is 1885.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.50 ACRE FEET PER ACRE DURING ANY PERIOD OF 30 DAYS OR 6.0 ACRE FEET DURING ANY IRRIGATION SEASON, if available at the authorized point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the sources.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 7, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 772, approving Transfer Application 9136, together with Certificate 79567, supercedes Certificate 2236, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
