CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROSS B HAMMOND
SISTERS, OR 97759

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW [WHYCHUS] CREEK, a tributary to the DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION of 62.4 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Pages 120 and 471. The date of priority thereby confirmed is 1906.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.248 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 75141, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 28 2014 approving Transfer Application T-11686.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
