CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WAIBEL RANCHES LLC 8055 SW POWELL BUTTE HWY POWELL BUTTE OR 97753

confirms the right to use the waters of CROOKED RIVER, tributary to DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION of 144.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 26104. The date of priority is APRIL 6, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.85 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 8, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 9, approving Transfer Application T-7341, and supersedes Certificate 32421, State record of Water Right Certificates.
