CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GRAY JAQUA COOK, LLC 35300 HENDRICKS RD CRESWELL OR 97426

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 91.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-46253. The date of priority is JULY 13, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.15 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

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The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

When required by the Department, the water user shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The water user shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor the accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 30, 2004, at Special Order Volume 60, Page 839, approving Transfer Application 9332, and together with Certificate 80874, supercedes Certificate 65852, State record of Water Right Certificates.
