CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use the waters of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 6.17 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, Page 9. The dates of priority are 1885 for 2.0 acres and 1887 for 4.17 acres.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.16 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), being 0.05 cfs under the 1885 priority date and 0.11 cfs under the 1887 priority date, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH (1/40) of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 86916, State Record of Water Right Certificates, reduced in rate by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 1, 2014, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-57, and together with Certificates 89165 and 89168 supersedes Certificate 86916.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
