CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 25.71 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, Page 9. The dates of priority are 1875 and 1893.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.64 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), being 0.21 cfs under the 1875 priority date and 0.43 cfs under the 1893 priority date, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above described decree.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
