 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 15.79 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, Page 9. The dates of priority are 1875, 1880, 1885, 1891, 1893, 1894, and 1896.

The use is limited to 1.5 miner's inches per acre, or 0.59 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above described decree.
