## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

R & B KAUER PROPERTIES LLC 721 NE ALLEN CT MCMINNVILLE OR 97128

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS, within the WEST BRANCH PALMER CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 126.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5158. The date of priority is JANUARY 11, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.58 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), in any combination from Well 2 and Well 3, further limited to no more than 1.54 CFS from Well 2 and no more than 1.42 CFS from Well 3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation as described as follows:
