CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LARRY K. AND BARBARA J. SHARPF
3730 TURNBRIDGE WELLS
SALEM, OR 97302

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, in the WYCHUS CREEK BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 1.10 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7092. The date of priority is DECEMBER 26, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.014 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The well is located as follows:

15 S	10 E	WM	26	NE SE	2750 FEET SOUTH AND 1310 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER OF SECTION 26

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.

This certificate confirms a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 28, 2011, at Special Order Volume 85, Page 473, approving Transfer Application T-10900, and together with Certificate 87239 supersedes Certificate 86162, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
